- 1. All members in good standing are entitled to submit ONE artwork to the Annual Symposium Exhibition with a \$36 registration fee. (Many of you already paid last year!)
- 2. No work older than 3 years is acceptable.
- 3. Only original work is eligible, meaning the submitted artwork is your own composition in concept and design, created solely by you. Artwork shall not be a copy of OR from reference material not solely created by the artists, such as purchased images, permission-granted images, stock photos, and published/unpublished copyrighted images. (For example, a portrait of a person taken directly from a printed publication that closely resembles the magazine image would not be eligible.)
- 4. DFAC receives a 40% commission on sales.
- 5. Consistent with FLAG's policy, no work that is POR (price on request) or NFS (not for sale) will be exhibited.

- 6. Two-dimensional artworks:
 - ~Maximum size: 60"h x 40"w or 40"h x 60"w including frame.
 - ~Properly wired (Sawtooth hardware will not be accepted!)
 - ~Work framed and covered must be under Plexiglas (Glass will not be accepted!)
- 7. Three-dimensional artwork must not exceed 100 lbs. in weight.
 - ~Maximum size: 5'h x 3'w x 3'd.
 - ~If a 3-dimensional work requires a pedestal, identify it on the FLAG registration form.
